The School of Global Environmental Sustainability (SoGES) is structurally and strategically designed to work across disciplinary boundaries to foster creative and innovative thinking about sustainability grand challenges.

SoGES attracts faculty and students working across, within, and beyond all eight of CSU's colleges to address sustainability at the intersection of social, environmental, and economic systems. We invest in unique activities to help address urgent global sustainability issues. We cultivate interdisciplinary research partnerships, incentivize interaction across disparate disciplines and expertise, educate the next generation of leaders, and generate meaningful dialogue about sustainability.

**FUNDING FOR RESEARCH:** SoGES provides seed funding for interdisciplinary, collaborative teams of faculty to build cross-campus partnerships and explore highly creative and atypical research approaches to global grand challenges. Funding is also available to individual faculty members looking to dedicate focused time and attention to an inventive research project they may not otherwise have resources or time to investigate.

**NETWORKING & ENGAGEMENT:** Part of the SoGES mission is to help connect researchers from across campus working on sustainability issues from disparate lenses. We facilitate programs to support faculty and researchers engaged in scholarly conversation about sustainability, including identification of strategic partnerships. We host faculty discussion sessions, ad hoc networking opportunities, dinners to connect faculty and local leaders and regular events including lectures, panels, and the SoGES Open House.

**EDUCATION & TRAINING FOR STUDENTS:** PhD students and postdocs can apply to become SoGES Sustainability Leadership Fellows, a year-long program focused on science communication and leadership development. SoGES administers the Minor in Global Environmental Sustainability as well as other interdisciplinary minors for undergraduate students. SoGES periodically offers funding for development of sustainability courses.
